



Elgin Experience CONTEST RULES

Entry deadline: 11:59 pm on Saturday, November 30, 2019.

CONTEST SPONSOR

The Experience Elgin Contest (the "Contest") is sponsored and administered by the County of Elgin, 450 Sunset Drive, St. Thomas ON N5R 5V1, 519-631-1460 x168.

CONTEST ELIGIBILITY

The Contest is open to persons who are, at the time of entry:

- Legal residents of Canada or the United States of America.
- Of the age of majority in their province, or territory of residence.

Persons meeting the above-enumerated criteria are hereinafter called "Contest Entrants".

County of Elgin personnel, agents, parents, directors, officers, affiliated or related companies, subsidiaries, divisions, prize providers, promotional and advertising agencies, affiliated or related companies, subsidiaries, divisions, prize providers, and their respective immediate family members, are not eligible to enter the Contest.

CONTEST PERIOD

The Contest begins at 2:00 pm ET on Friday, March 1, 2019 and ends at 11:59 pm ET on Saturday, November 30, 2019. (the "Contest Period").

HOW TO ENTER

During the Contest Period, to be eligible to win a Prize, Contest Entrants must submit their Contest Entries online by visiting www.elgintourist.com/winanelginexperience before the end of the Contest Period, and complete the Online Entry Form.

Only one Contest Entry per email address will be accepted during the Contest Period. In the event it is discovered that any individual attempted to enter the Contest more than once, successive entries all of that individual will be disqualified. Entries generated by a script, macro or other automated means are void. Entries that contain typographical errors, are altered, tampered with, incomplete, inaccurate, irregular in any way, or otherwise not in compliance with these Contest Rules, are also void.

No correspondence will be entered into except with selected entrants.



SELECTION OF CONTEST WINNERS

Entries that comply with these Rules and that are received prior to December 1, 2019 will be eligible for a random draw conducted by the Contest Administrator. There are a total of one giveaway on the draw date:

ONE PRIZE PER WINNING ENTRANT

Only one Prize will be awarded to a single entrant.

ODDS OF WINNING

The odds of winning depend on the total number of Eligible Contest Entries received.

REQUIREMENTS TO CLAIM PRIZE

The Prize Winner (“Winner”) will be notified by phone and/or e-mail within five (5) business days from the date of the prize draw in which their winning entry is selected. If the Winner cannot be contacted within a period of five (5) business days from the applicable monthly draw date, or should the Winner not comply with these Contest Rules, he or she will forfeit the Prize.

All Winners must execute a statement of Eligibility and Publicity (“Statement”), pursuant to which the Winner will:

- Confirm their compliance with these Contest Rules;
- Confirm their acceptance of the Prize as awarded;
- Consent to the publication of their name for publicity purposes.

The Statement must be executed and returned to the Contest Administrator, as instructed on the Statement, within five (5) business days of the date the Statement is postmarked (if sent via postal mail), or the date the email is sent.

The Winner will be confirmed by the Contest Administrator upon the Contest Administrator’s confirmation that he / she has complied with these Contest Rules and completed and returned a signed Statement. The Contest Sponsor will follow up with prizing fulfillment.

In the event of non-compliance with these Contest Rules, and/or if a Winner cannot be reached via the contact information supplied on the Contest Entry, or the statement is not fully completed and signed



by the Winner, the prize will be forfeited and an alternate eligible entry may, in the sole discretion of the Contest Administrator, be selected.

DELIVERY OF PRIZE

The Winner will be instructed on the procedure to claim his / her Prize by the Contest Administrator.

All Prizes must be accepted as awarded and are not transferable to cash or alternative merchandise, subject to the right of the Contest Administrator to make Prize substitutions of equivalent monetary value to that described above.
