- 1 Swains Greenhouse** a family owned Farming Corporation including; 4 ½ acres of greenhouse, authentic handmade furniture, and a Texas style restaurant.
- 2 Scenic Lookout** One of many picturesque views of the breathtaking Lake Erie, located at Graham Rd. and Gray Line south of Eagle. The route travels along side the Elgin Hiking Trail.
- 3 Port Glasgow Marina** gateway to the Great Lakes, with 80 docks, hydro, water, showers, bathrooms, gasoline, beach, food/snack booth, and picnic area.
- 4 Old Jail** built in 1890 for \$200.00 the Rodney jail is the oldest and smallest jail in North America.
- 5 Joes Bush** a beautiful and rare 50-acre ancient Carolinian forest donated to the municipality of West Elgin by Joe Schmid.
- 6 McKillop Farm** traditional fifth generation family-owned farm including corn soybeans, wheat, alfalfa, charolais cows, and laying hens.
- 7 Rest Area, Parking and Seasonal Restrooms** If you need a break here's your chance, located at Talbot Line and Dunborough Road, East of Eagle.
